- Only for some students with 1 or 0 NT-Level Subject pass

## 3. 4-Year Enhanced Higher NITEC Courses (JIE-E){NEW}

- Retail & Online Business
- Only for some students with 1 or 0 NT-Level Subject pass

## 4. Traineeship Courses (TRN)

- All students can apply
- Must attend Online Pre-Interview Session
- Attend Interview Session by Company

If you are passionate with strong aptitude related to a *Higher Nitec* or *Nitec* course, and keen to pursue your studies in ITE, the ITE EAE is for you.

#### If you are

- Singapore Citizen (SC) or Singapore Permanent Resident (SPR) who has registered to sit for the GCE N-Level examinations in 2023
- International Student (IS) enrolled in a Government, Government-aided or Independent School, and has registered to sit for the GCE N-Level examinations in 2023
- SC or SPR who has sat for the GCE N-Level examinations previously

# Posting of Applicants under JIE 'N'

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Type of Bonus Point	Details
Excellent (2 bonus points)	Students who attains a min Level 3 in all four domains (Participation, Achievement, Leadership, Service) with at least a Level 4 in one domain
Good (1 bonus point)	Student who attains a min level 1 in four domains with any of the following <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. At least Level 2 in 3 domains;</li><li>2. At least level 2 in one domain and at least level 3 in another domain; or</li><li>3. At least Level 4 in one domain.</li></ol>
Fair	Student's attainment in co-curriculum activities will not translate into any bonus point.

- **How & When to apply for courses :**
- **TODAY** - Use the Laptop/iPad provided **in the Indoor Sports Hall** for application (if you know which courses to apply for; speak to your ISC Teacher if you have queries)
- **AT HOME** (read the ITE Admission Booklet for information)
- **AT CREST** - Laptops will be available at the Booktique till **20 Dec 2023 (8.30 – 11.30am)** for you to submit your application.
- **AT ITE** - Visit and apply at the ITE College that you like to enrol in. (Speak to ITE Lecturers at the College on your queries)

# ITE Full-Time Course Application

- **Important advice :**
  - There is very keen competition for courses, esp. popular courses.
  - Apply for your courses **early** i.e. Apply during **1<sup>st</sup> Application Phase** (from today **18 Dec to 21 Dec** by 5 P.M.)
  - Choose **All 12 Course Options** during application to maximise chances of a successful course offer and posting.
  - Put the **course that requires interview as 1<sup>st</sup> Choice.**
  - **Successful ITE EAE applicants**
  - **101** Sec 4 students who have accepted provisional offers earlier **have secured your ITE course** - Congratulations!!!
  - You do not have to apply for a course now.
  - Course transfer is **not** allowed.
  - You will receive SMS confirmation on your course offer from ITE today, and a Letter of Offer next week.

# *Unsuccessful Applications and Appeals*

- If unsuccessful and posted to another Course or College, **ACCEPT THE COURSE FIRST. (DO NOT REJECT)**
- You can appeal for your preferred Course/College during the APPEAL PHASE in Early Jan.
- If you **REJECT**, you will not be able to appeal and will need to re-apply again in the later phase. There will be very few vacancies by then.

## ITE Fees, Financial Assistance, Bursaries & Scholarships

- ITE Fees for Singaporeans is **\$233** for **every 6 months**. Can be paid with your edusave. **(\$3,121/\$8756.10 for SPR/IS)**
- There are plenty of financial support schemes such as MOE Bursary, ITE Community Scholarship, etc.
- Various Awards and Scholarships from Edusave, Foundations & Employers. Refer to Website and Application Booklet for details.

# Getting into your Course of Choice

Key Criteria	Remarks
Meet all entry requirements (Most Courses need 3 NT subject passes)	Compulsory
• Pre-requisite Subject (if any)	Math, EL or Both
• No Colour Appreciation Deficiency (if necessary)	Pass Colour Blind Test
• Drawing Test & Portfolio (if necessary)	Able to show Aptitude
• Medical Health (if necessary)	Pass Medical Examination
Best 4 Subject Aggregate	For ranking purpose
Conduct Grade & Regular Attendance	Very important for appeal
Physical Appearance and Observable Attributes	Very important for appeal
Communication Skills, Confidence	Very important for appeal
