TERM 4 – KEY EVENTS, PROGRAMMES AND NOTIFICATIONS

REFLECTIONS ON TERM 3

1. Term 3 has been an uplifting term filled with many events to enrich our student development experiences. We had a series of learning journeys, Mother Tongue cultural immersion programmes, outdoor adventure learning camp and student-initiated-learning presentations for our Secondary 1 to 4, amidst whole-school celebrations for Racial Harmony Day, National Day and Teachers' Day. We were heartened to see students enjoying the bonding and interaction with one another across classes and showcasing their learning in various ways.
2. I would like to take this opportunity to thank all Secondary 2 and 3 parents who joined us for our online and face-to-face Parents' Dialogue with School Leaders respectively. We hope that you have found these engagement sessions useful.

ASSESSMENT MATTERS

GCE N-LEVEL EXAMINATION & CHANGES TO TERM 4 TIMETABLE

3. The GCE N-Level Examination will commence on 12 September 2023 (Tuesday). Hence, the school's reporting and dismissal times for Secondary 1 to 3 levels will be adjusted in Term 4. Secondary 4 students will also have a revised daily schedule during this period. **Annex A** provides a summary of the Assessment Schedule, Dismissal Adjustments and Key Events. Please note that you will only receive the information for your child's/ward's level.

SECONDARY 1 TO 3 END-OF-YEAR ASSESSMENT

4. Secondary 3 students will start their End-of-Year Assessment from 3 October 2023 (Tuesday) to 9 October 2023 (Monday).

Secondary 1 & 2 students will start their End-of-Year Assessment from 9 October 2023 (Monday) to 16 October 2023 (Monday).

5. Marking Day for Secondary 3 will be on 10 October 2023 (Tuesday). Secondary 3 students will not need to report to school on that day.

Marking Day for Secondary 1 & 2 will be on 17 October 2023 (Tuesday). Secondary 1 & 2 students will not need to report to school on that day.

6. Students will be dismissed after their last paper for each day of the exam.
7. For students who do not have a paper on a particular day, they are not required to report to school that day.
8. It is important to note that your child/ward will require a medical certificate if he/she is unable to attend the examination. No parent's/guardian's letter will be accepted, unless your child/ward is tested COVID-positive.

INDUSTRY EXPERIENTIAL PROGRAMME (IEP)

10. As part of the ITE Skills Subject Certificate (ISSC) requirements, all Secondary 3 students will need to participate in the IEP from 23 October to 18 November 2023. Please do not plan for any holiday during this period as it is still considered as curriculum time.
11. This year, about 95% of our students have been successfully placed with a company for their work attachment.
12. We thank all parents for their support in the external IEP programme. We believe that the authentic and real world work experience will bring much benefit to our students.

CCA STAND-DOWN

13. All CCA activities for Secondary 1 & 2 students will stand down from Term 4 Week 4 while Sec 3 will stand down in Week 3 due to the End-of-Year Assessment.
