ITE SKILLS SUBJECT CERTIFICATE (ISSC) COMBINATION SELECTION

- 10. A Parents Gateway (PG) message will be sent to Secondary 2 students on 18 October 2024 regarding the submission of their ISS combination selection. The deadline for submitting the ISS combination selection is 30 October 2024, at 5 PM. For students who do not submit their choice of ISS combination, the school will allocate one for them. Secondary 2 students will receive the results of their ISS combination allocation on 13 November 2024, which will be communicated through PG. Students wishing to appeal for a change to another ISS combination must provide a valid reason. The appeal form (link available on the school website) must be submitted online by 14 November 2024, at 5 PM, and the outcome of the appeal will be communicated to parents by 15 November 2024.
- 11. Starting January 2025, we will rename the current Taster Modules to **Discovery Modules** with the intention of igniting and exciting Lower Secondary students' interest in vocational learning. This change aims to build foundational skills that span multiple subjects and incorporate 21st-century skills, such as adaptive and inventive thinking, as key objectives. The new structure of the Discovery Modules will also allow for reduced timetable periods where possible.

14. As part of our outreach efforts, we will hold engagement sessions at our school for Primary 6 students from 31 October 2024, Tuesday to 1 November 2024, Wednesday. Selected Secondary 1, 2, and 4 students will interact with the Primary 6 students during these sessions.

OPEN HOUSE FOR PRIMARY 6 STUDENTS

15. The school will hold an Open House for Primary 6 students in November, and it will take place over four days, from 20 November 2024, Wednesday to 23 November 2024, Saturday. Selected Secondary 1, 2, 3, and 4 students will participate in the event, including preparatory

work on <u>19 November 2024, Tuesday</u>. Parents and guardians will be informed of their child's or ward's involvement in the event via Parents Gateway at a later date.

ENHANCING INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITIES

- 16. The school has successfully completed the refurbishment of several school facilities, including the school facade, canteen, student hub, parade square, multi-purpose hall, outdoor learning shed, sensory spaces for student wellness and re-turfing of the school field this year. When the new term begins in 2025, students and staff can look forward to even more fantastic facilities, such as upgraded classrooms, staff rooms, and innovative learning areas designed for exploration and hands-on experiences.
- 17. We're confident that these improvements will not only elevate our students' learning but also foster a more welcoming, dynamic, and inspiring school environment.

- 18. The school's opening hours during the year-end school holidays will be from 8.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays.
