TERM 4 - KEY EVENTS, PROGRAMMES AND NOTIFICATIONS

REFLECTIONS ON TERM 3

- 1. Term 3 has been an inspiring and eventful period, filled with numerous activities aimed at enriching our students' developmental experiences. Our Secondary 1 to 4 students participated in various learning journeys, Mother Tongue cultural immersion programmes, an Outdoor Adventure Learning Camp, and Student-Initiated Learning presentations. Additionally, the entire school came together to celebrate Racial Harmony Day, National Day, and Teachers' Day. It was heartening to witness the students' enthusiasm as they bonded across classes and proudly showcased their learning in diverse ways.
- 2. I would like to take this opportunity to thank all Secondary 2 parents who joined us for our online Parents' Engagement Session with School Leaders. We hope that you have found the engagement sessions useful.
- 3. Crest Secondary School is committed to providing the best school experience for our students, and that's why we've been upgrading our facilities, with our major renovation plans that began since last year. We are pleased to share that the upgrading of the glass canopy, parts of the school's external façade, and link bridge are largely completed. We are currently awaiting final clearance from the Building and Construction Authority (BCA) to reopen the roundabout for vehicular traffic. We recognize that the ongoing construction has caused some inconvenience, particularly with the need to take alternative routes to access the school, and we truly appreciate your patience. We will provide an update as soon as we can safely reopen the roundabout.
- 4. As part of our continuous efforts to enhance the learning environment, we will be undertaking further renovations at the end of Term 4. These upgrades will focus on improving our classrooms, staff rooms and learning spaces to better support our students. We thank you for your understanding and ongoing support as we work to create a better experience for our school community.

ASSESSMENT MATTERS

GCE N-Level Examination & Changes to Term 4 Timetable

6. The GCE N-Level Examination will commence on 9 September 2024, Monday. Hence, the school's reporting and dismissal times for Secondary 1 to 3 will be adjusted in Term 4. Secondary 4 students will also have a revised daily schedule during this period. <u>Annex A provides a summary of the Assessment Schedule</u>, Dismissal Adjustments and Key Events. Please note that you will only receive the information for your child's/ward's level.

SECONDARY 1 TO 3 END-OF-YEAR ASSESSMENTS

- 7. Secondary 1 to 3 students will have their End-of-Year Assessments from 7 October 2024 to 14 October 2024.
- 8. Marking Day for Secondary 1 to 3 will be on 15 October 2024, Tuesday. All students will not need to report to school on that day. Please refer to the assessment schedule in Annex A.
- 9. Students will be dismissed after their last paper for each day of the exam.
- 10. For students who do not have a paper on a particular day, they are not required to report to school on that day.
- 11. It is important to note that your child/ward will require a medical certificate if he/she is unable to attend the examination. **No parent's/guardian's letter will be accepted**.

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INDUSTRY EXPERIENTIAL PROGRAMME (IEP)

- 13. As part of the ITE Skills Subject Certificate (ISSC) requirements, all Secondary 3 students will need to participate in the IEP from <u>21 October to 16 November 2024</u>. Please do not plan for any holiday during this period as it is still considered as curriculum time.
- 14. We thank all parents for their support in the external IEP programme. We believe that the real world work experience will bring much benefit to our students.

SECURITY INCIDENT DRILL

15. The school will be conducting a security incident drill on 17 October 2024, Thursday. As part of the SGSecure framework to safeguard Singapore, this exercise aims to ensure the safety and well-being of all students and staff by preparing them to respond to emergencies in the school premises and be familiar with the safety and evacuation procedures.

CCA STAND-DOWN

Do note that these dates are tentative and subject to changes.

FINAL NOTE

- 20. While Term 4 is a shorter school term, it is an important one as all Secondary 1 to 3 students will be taking their End-of-Year Assessment, which will affect their progression to the next level. We urge all parents/guardians to supervise and encourage your child/ward to stay focused on his/her revision.
- 21. To our ninth graduating batch of Secondary 4 students, we would like to wish them all the very best in their performance at the GCE N-Level and ISSC Examination. To enable them to stay connected to the school after their graduation, the school will request for their personal contact details, including their contact numbers and email addresses, so that they can continue to receive information from the school. In addition, they can continue to use their Crest email account (ending with crestsec.edu.sg) until 30 June 2025, Monday.
- 22. I hope everyone had a restful September school holidays and are all rejuvenated to start Term 4.
