# **THINGS TO BRING FOR ORAL EXAM**

## **MUST REMEMBER!**

- ☑ Entry Proof
- ☑ NRIC/Foreign identification/  
Student Concession Pass
- ☑ Stationery such as black or blue pens/pencils/  
ruler/eraser



1. **Check** your belongings to make sure you have everything you need before you leave home.
2. Ensure that you do not have any unauthorised materials or devices (eg. **Notes, slip of paper, etc** ) in your **pencil case** before you enter the silent preparation area for oral.
3. If found in possession, it will be regarded as an attempt to cheat and marks may not be taken into consideration.

## **BEFORE YOU GO TO THE SILENT PREP STATION**

If you are wearing an outerwear (e.g. jackets, cardigan, sweater), **make sure to remove it before moving to the Silent Prep Station.**

## Cannot bring to hall (exam venue):

**Electronic, communication and computerised devices, including but not limited to:**

- **Mobile phone**
- **Ear buds**
- **Smart Watch**
- **Fitness trackers**
- **Tablet**
- **Camera / Audio recorder**
- **Smart Glasses**



- **Listen carefully** to all announcements given by the exam personnel.
- Ensure that you **adhere to these instructions** at all times.



NO COMMUNICATION IS ALLOWED (e.g. talk, gesture, etc) with other candidates inside or outside the examination venue (e.g. restroom) during the examination.



Inform the examination personnel if you need any assistance.



DO NOT share examination materials. They must **NOT** be reproduced, uploaded, posted, transmitted or distributed in any way.

# IMPORTANT!

**Familiarise yourself and comply with all examination rules and regulations.** If you breach any examination rules and regulations, you may be:

- a) prohibited from taking the examination;
- b) expelled from the examination room;
- c) refused entry for subsequent papers;
- d) have your results terminated or a grade penalty; and/ or
- e) banned from registering for the examinations in future years.



# BEFORE YOU ENTER THE EXAMINATION VENUE

Ensure you have:

1. Entry Proof AND NRIC/ Foreign Identification documents/ Student Concession Card. This is required for verifying your attendance for the exam.

2. Pen to sign your attendance.

Before heading to the Silent Prep Station,

- keep all your revision/ reading materials
- leave them on the chair or hand the revision/ reading materials over to your teacher

Before you report:

# Step 1: Report to Harmony Hub

- At 1.45 pm or 2pm, report to Harmony Hub:
- Sit according to your team in the correct order
- Surrender belongings to the teacher
  - Phone and smart watches – switched off
  - Bags to be placed on trolley
- Make sure you have
  - IC / EZ-link / Passport
  - Revision notes and pen
  - Entry proof

# Step 2: Hall

## Station 1: Waiting Area

- Read your notes quietly.
- If you need the washroom, let the teacher know.
  - You **must** be escorted by a teacher.
- Before you leave for your turn:
  - Leave your notes and pens on the chair (make sure your name is written)
  - Check that you have your entry proof, NRIC / EZ-Link / Passport
  - Check your attire and grooming

**Waiting area: Sit here and revise your notes quietly**



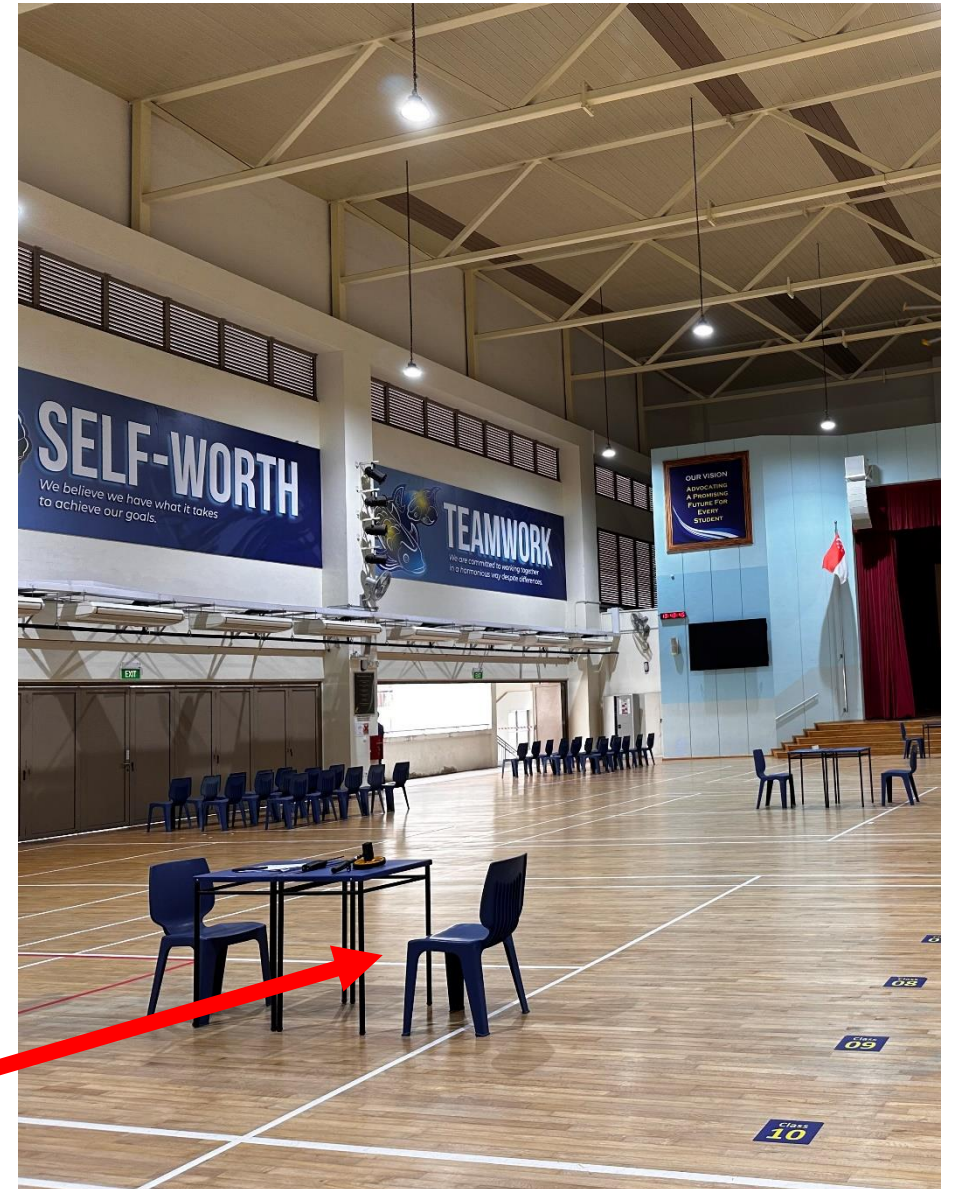


# Step 2: Hall

## Station 2: Silent Prep Station

- Proceed to the prep laptop based on your assigned exam team.
- **User ID and Password** for the preparation will be on the table beside the prep laptop. You have to key in the details.
- You will either have **10 minutes** or **13 minutes** of prep time.
- Timer is in the exam system online.
  
- Once done, move to the waiting chair if it is not occupied.
- If it is occupied, stay put.
- **Do not communicate with the others.**

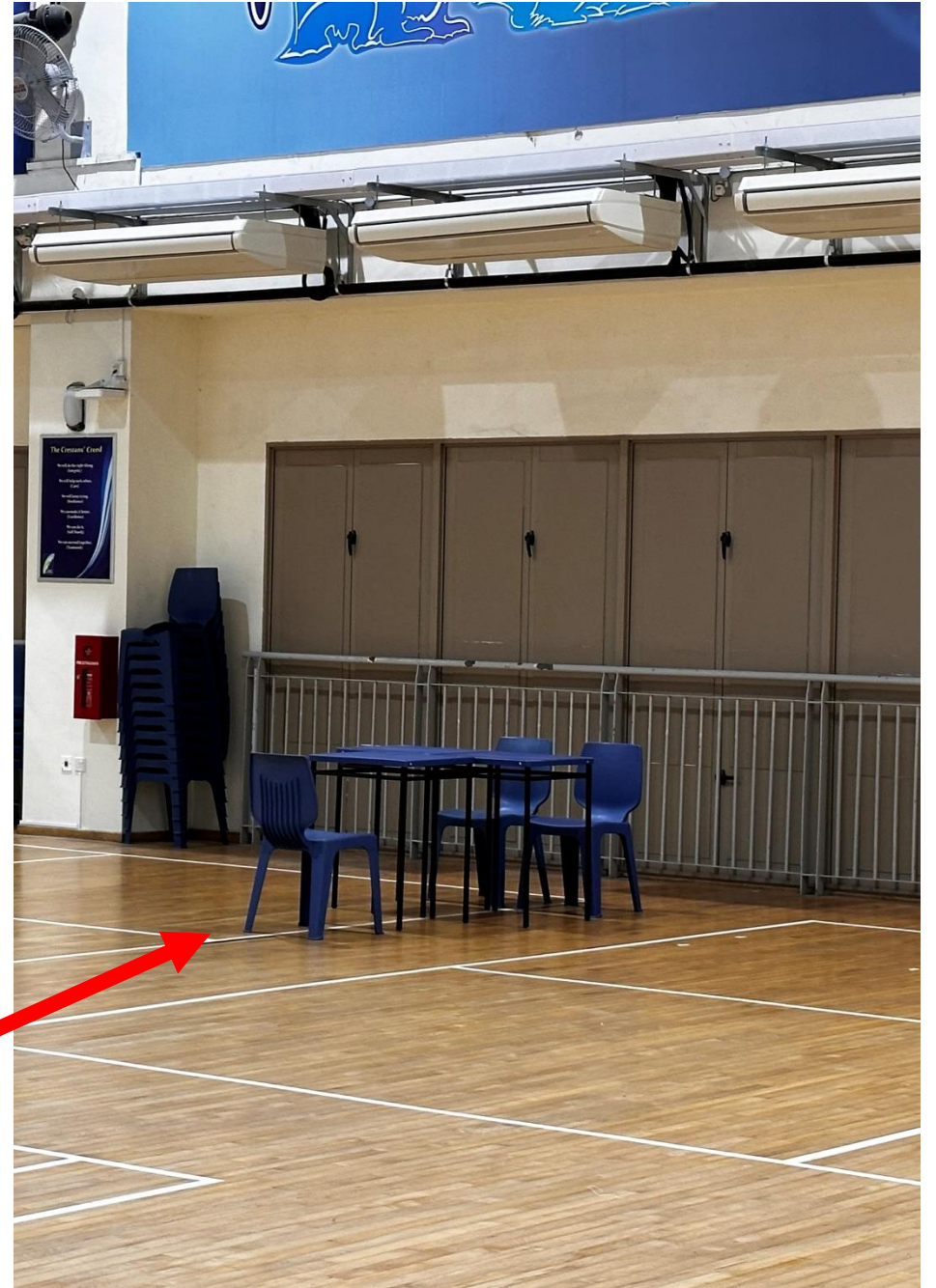
# Step 2: Hall

- Thank the examiners at the end 😊

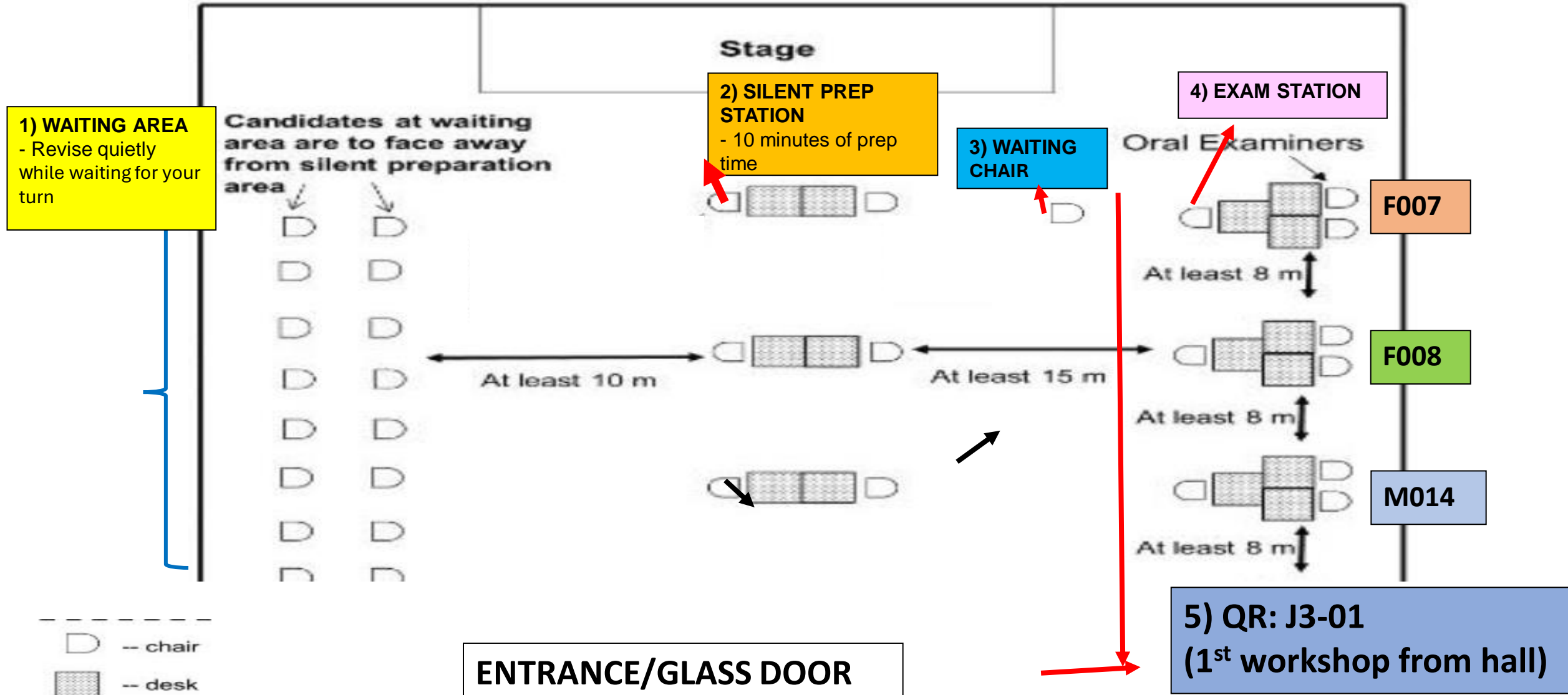

# STEP 3 – Leave Quarantine Room

## Before 3 pm,

- Walk to quarantine room (*J3-01-first workshop beside toilet nearer to hall*) quietly after you are done with oral exam. (same as Prelims)
- Do not communicate or have eye contact with other candidates along the way.
- Wait in quarantine room if you are done before 3 p.m.
- **You can only leave after 3 p.m.**



## STEP 3 – Leave Quarantine Room

**After 3 pm,**

- Take your belongings.
- Check that all items are accounted for.
- Proceed to link bridge and go to level 2 (*HOD level*).
- Pass by HOD office and proceed to level 1.
- Leave via the front gate (*same as how you come to school in the morning*)
- **Maintain silence** until you reach level one.

# General Guidelines- VERY IMPT REMINDERS!

- Maintain silence throughout
  - Do not talk to others along the corridor
- Once you leave the waiting area to go to the silent prep station, you should only have:
  - NRIC / EZ – Link / Passport
  - Entry proof
  - **NO NOTES ALLOWED**

- Namelists will be pasted outside Level 4 staffroom by week 4.
- Check the team you are in and the day of oral exam.
