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 Enable Crestans to learn and apply skills and competencies as part of their fulfilment of the ITE Skills Subject Certificate (ISSC) course.

BEFORE & DURING IEP

Teacher mentor will be assigned

 Liaise with workplace and parents when needed

 Conduct regular checks through WhatsApp or calls





BEFORE & DURING IEP

For Parents

- Do not plan any holidays from 21 Oct to 16 Nov 2024
- May contact teacher-mentor or the school
- Refrain from visiting the workplace



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Do give encouragement



BEFORE & DURING IEP

For Students

- Inform supervisor and teacher-mentor when they are unwell
- See a doctor, get an MC and submit it to the workplace and teacher- mentor promptly the next working day
- Parents' letter not accepted
- If hurt during work, report to supervisor and teacher-mentor immediately
