REFLECTIONS ON TERM 2

- 1. At the end of Term 2, we concluded our "Keep Right Programme" with fun-filled activities such as Sports Day, Snookball & Soccer Interclass games, as well as various learning journeys to places such as Little India, Chinatown and Bird Paradise for the different levels. On 27 May 2024 (Mon), parents, students and teachers came together for the Parent-Student-Teacher Conference (PSTC).
