TEMPERATURE -TAKING EXERCISE

12. Term 3 temperature-taking exercise will be held on 29 June (Wednesday). This exercise aims to maintain the school's preparedness to activate the temperature-taking regime should the need arise, and to educate students on taking responsibility for their own health. All students are to bring their Oral Digital Thermometers (ODT) on 28 Jun (Tuesday) for serviceability check by their Form Teachers.

ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

- 13. Please note the School and Miscellaneous Fees Payment for both Term 3 and 4 will be deducted/paid by 1 August (Monday) via GIRO deduction or cash/cheque/NETS/PayNow.
- 14. The national stance in response to the development of Covid-19 will continue to evolve and change. The school stands ready to respond to all measures necessary to safe-guard the health of everyone, so that learning can continue to take place. We strongly encourage your child/ward to receive the booster vaccination against COVID-19 if he/she is eligible. Please note that from 1 June 2022, recovered individuals will need to receive the booster dose within 9 months after completing their primary vaccination series, and at least 28 days after infection in order to maintain their vaccinated status.
- 15. With the cessation of SafeEntry in the school, there is no need for use of the TT token. However, please note that your child/ward is strongly encouraged to keep the TT application on their phones and/or hold on to their TT tokens, so that the school may rapidly step up contact tracing and checks should these be needed in response to any new variant of concern. We seek your partnership to inform the school if your child/ward is unwell or is tested positive for COVID-19.
