 No Colour Appreciation Deficiency (if necessary) 	Pass Colour Blind Test
 Drawing Test & Portfolio (if necessary) 	Able to show Aptitude
 Medical Health (if necessary) 	Pass Medical Examination
Best 4 Subject Aggregate	For ranking purpose
Conduct Grade & Regular Attendance	Very important for appeal
Physical Appearance and Observable Attributes	Very important for appeal
Communication Skills, Confidence	Very important for appeal
